This was the year that we grew stronger in numbers. During this year, God has sustained our 189 sponsored children, enabling 5 of them to graduate this year. He also blessed us with 384+ children per week in our feeding areas through our partner churches who tirelessly preached the Gospel despite difficulty and challenges. It was also during this year that 87 senior citizens heard the Gospel. 8 of the seniors were baptized. Moreover, 130 families were assisted with relief goods when they were hit by typhoons.

This year, the Lord truly blessed us in ways that we cannot imagine. As you read the contents of this report, our prayer is that you too will experience the joy we felt as we saw the numbers and read the stories of God's work in the lives of children, parents, students, laborers, and senior citizens.

Giving relief packs

We partner with our local pastors to identify members in the community who need help. These were often those who were not given relief by the government due to limited slots. Relief packs given include basic necessities like rice, canned goods, and other essentials.

We also gave monetary assistance to families whose houses were damaged and churches that were damaged due to the floods and strong winds brought by the typhoon. The assistance was used to purchase materials and pay for the labor for the repair of the homes and churches.

Good day, I am Pastor Manuel Opanda of Christ In You Antipolo, and I would like to testify to the greatness and goodness of our Lord in our ministry in Sitio Malalim Baras Rizal. Our work began at the start of the year 2024, in January. A pastor friend told me that because of the pandemic, the work in Malalim Baras stopped, and the people there are also not continuing the Lord's work. When I went to the place in December 2023, I prayed for the will of the Lord. Together with the two families, we planned to continue the work there.

On the 3rd Sunday of January, we formally started the young people and adult Bible Study. One of our concern are the children. There are many children in the area, and we are thinking about how we can reach them again. However, we lack the manpower and budget to hold activities for them. 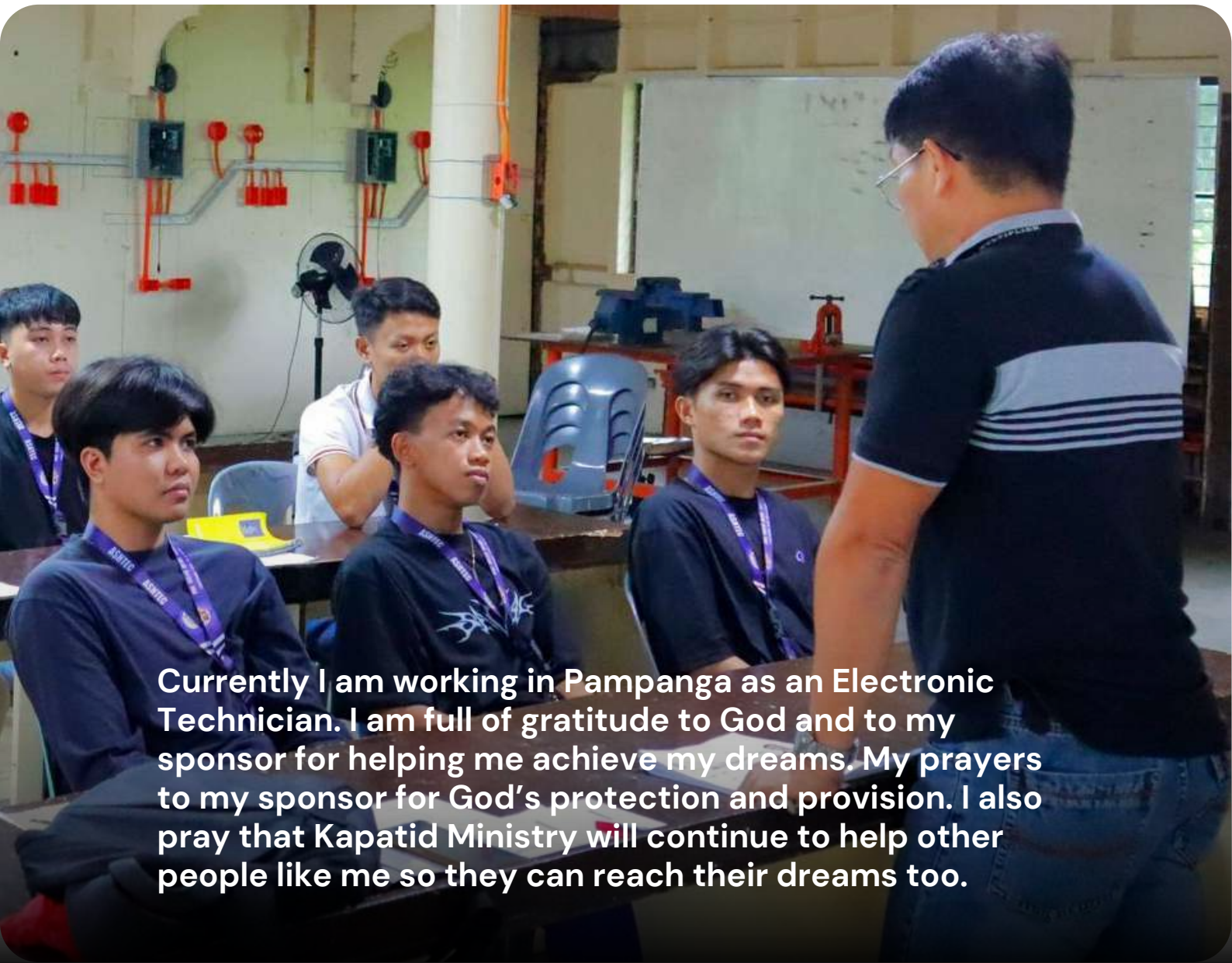


CHILD SPONSORSHIP PROGRAM

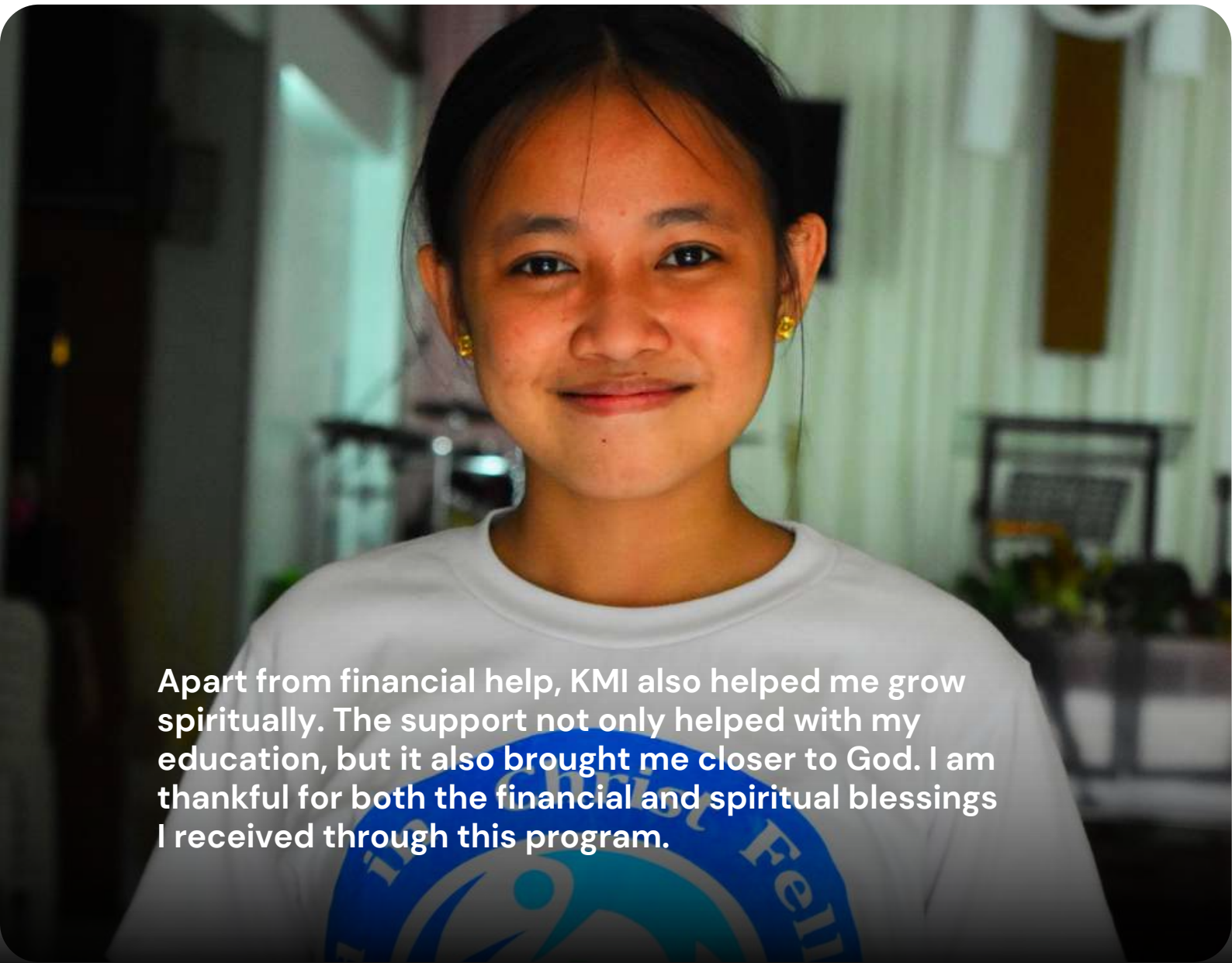


CHILD SPONSORSHIP PROGRAM

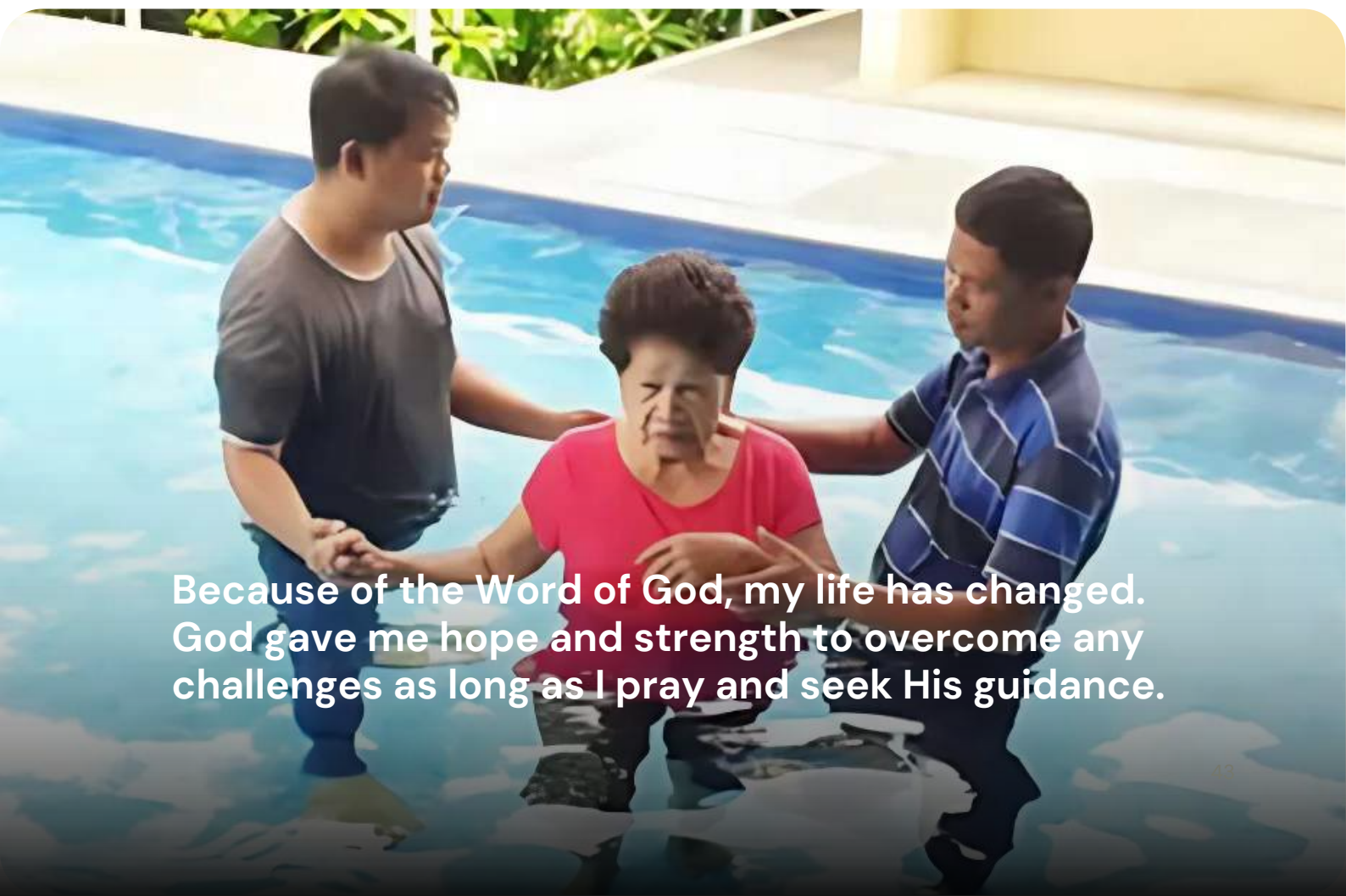
BLESS A SENIOR PROGRAM

"Some of us are senders, and some are goers. Neither is more important than the other. Neither is possible without the other." May God bless you abundantly.

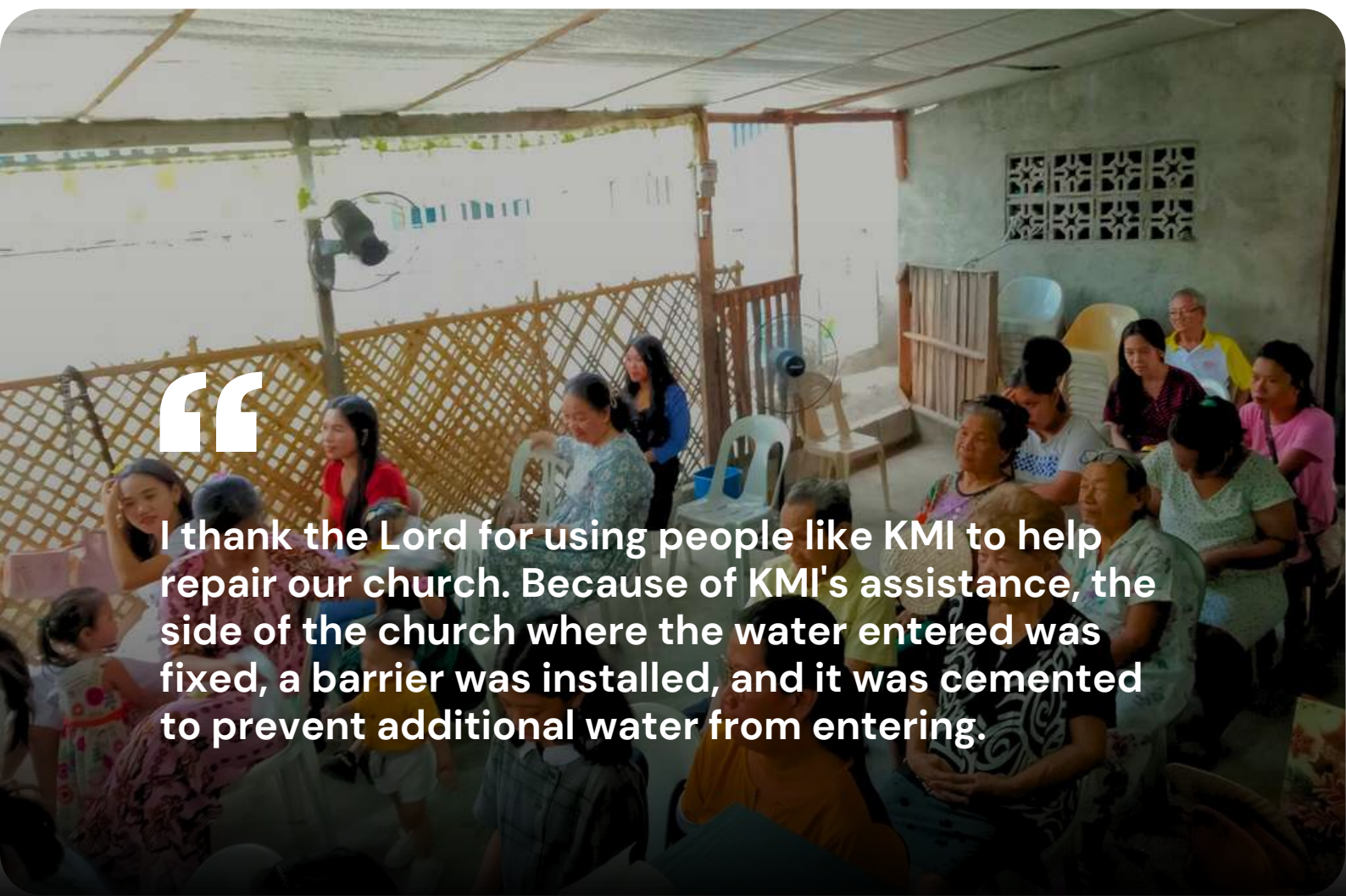


CALAMITY ASSISTANCE
