Message of The CEO

2022 has been a year of opportunity and challenges. Having come out of the pandemic experiencing various kinds of trials, Filipinos were both relieved as well as concerned as to how a post-pandemic world would be. Churches also were not left unscathed by the pandemic, with some churches losing members and others experiencing much trial and tribulation – leading to a feeling of uncertainty. Even Kapatid Ministry, was unsure as to how to minister to a post-pandemic Filipino society. Yet, by God’s grace and guidance, opportunities for the furtherance of the Gospel abounded in these times of trials.



This 2022, our partner churches in the feeding ministry were able to restart their feeding program and church planting efforts. 19 of our partners were able to sustain their feeding programs without our support, freeing us to support other feeding programs. We also were able to support church planting efforts in Tagaytay, Batangas, Naguilian, and Lubao, Pampanga – with the number of feeding centers being supported financially going up to 9.

Our child sponsorship program also continues to be sustained by our sponsors who faithfully and consistently support the education of our sponsored children. One notable sponsored child, who was sponsored since 2004 has finally graduated from college. We praise God for his sponsor's faithfulness in consistently supporting his education for all these years. We also praise God for the child's sponsor family, his church, and his own volition and desire as all play a hand in helping him graduate. Indeed, it is true, that it takes a village to raise a child. Our child sponsorship program bears evidence of this.

Another notable program that was launched during the pandemic was the Bless a Senior Citizen program. We partnered with churches in bringing the gospel to senior citizens as church members were mobilized to visit and give gifts to senior citizens in the community. The goal was to build connections and pave the way for the Gospel to be proclaimed to

them. We thank God as this has led to 330 senior citizens ministered and 24 new bible studies started among them. One partner testified that they were able to share the Gospel to a senior citizen before he passed away a few weeks after their visit. We thank God for the salvation He has brought even until the eleventh hour.

All these programs have been made possible through the faithfulness of our partner pastors, the unwavering commitment of their volunteer workers and church members, the consistency and loving support of our donors and financial partners, the love and support of our friends in the ministry, the eagerness and resiliency of the families being ministered to, and the hopes and dreams and passion of the children being ministered to. All of these reflects the faithfulness and sovereignty of our God, who is faithful in redeeming His people who will be transformed and bring Him honor and glory.

Finally, we are grateful for the life of Pastor Charlie, our partner pastor in the feeding program and child sponsorship program in Christ In You, Novaliches, Quezon City. Pastor Charlie passed away last August 24, 2022 after a long battle with cancer, leaving behind his wife, Sister Amor, and son AC. He was a faithful co-laborer in the Lord, who considered others more significant than self, and who showed an example of what it means to serve the Lord. He will be missed.

Indeed this 2022 was a challenging time. In times like this, 1 Corinthians 15:58 comforts us, for it says, *"Therefore, my beloved brothers, be steadfast, immovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, knowing that in the Lord your labor is not in vain."* It is faithful labor that will bear fruit, proving once again the God who we serve is faithful in accomplishing His will, in our case, in transforming communities, one family at a time – no matter what circumstance.

I am the owner of the rainbow siomai business that you invested in. The business's name is Rainbow Siomai because of the different colored wrappers of the siomai. It can be bought for 20 pesos and you will have five pieces of rainbow siomai. Actually, I chose this business because it was recommended to me by my brother. My first choice is actually a sari-sari store, but my brother suggested that I try to sell rainbow siomai that he saw at an innovation event at



their school, and I thought it was interesting and a good idea. That's why I propose rainbow siomai instead of the sari-sari store. When I started running my business, the good things that happened to me were the boost in confidence and the ability to socialize with other people. I am the type of person who spends all of their time at school and at home.

I only have a few friends, so I don't try to socialize with other people or to speak in front of a lot of people, which was the result of me having low self-confidence, but when I started selling rainbow siomai, little by little, I am getting out of my comfort zone and trying to socialize with other people. This business not only benefits me personally but also financially, because when I am short on money and need to complete school requirements, I borrow from the Rainbow Siomai Fund, so that I pass my required requirements. This business also became helpful in the community in that they now have a place to go once they are looking for a merienda vendor. In running my business, I have also encountered difficulties and challenges. The first is an increase in price. The second is the location of the business, which is in the alley. That is why

only a limited number of customers can see and buy it. The third is my sales schedule. I sold rainbow siomai on Wednesday and Saturday at first, but because only 3 customers bought on a simple day and because one of my customers also requested that I move my schedule from Wednesday to Sunday because that's when the workers get their salary, I listened to their request and I moved my Wednesday schedule to Sunday, but the problem I had on Sunday was that we have a service in church. That is why sometimes I am not selling rainbow siomai on Sunday. There are also a few reasons why I rarely sell rainbow siomai. First is having a review for the qualifying exam that I need to pass. Second is having a wound on my foot, which is painful when it gets hit, so it's hard for me to walk. The third is that we are renovating the house to welcome another addition to our family.

Lastly, I work at the barangay as a SPES Scholar. Working at the barangay is one of the requirements in receiving a scholarship, which included completing 160 hours. That's why, I have to stop the business to give priority to my studies.



Even though I decided not to pursue my business I am glad that I became part of the YES program. I met Pastor Titus Jr., Mr. Joemel, Mr. Dwight, Ms. Rhoro, Ms. Hazel, my fellow youth who are part of the YES program, and you too.

I thank you for believing in me and my abilities despite the fact that this is my first time running a business, and I also appreciate the assistance you have provided. I also want to thank God for the blessings he has given me. As Ms. Rhoro previously stated, this is not the end of my journey into running a business, but rather the beginning, and everything I learned from running a business in a few months will be treasured and used if and when the opportunity arises. 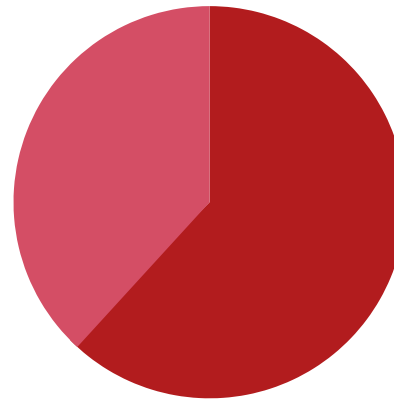

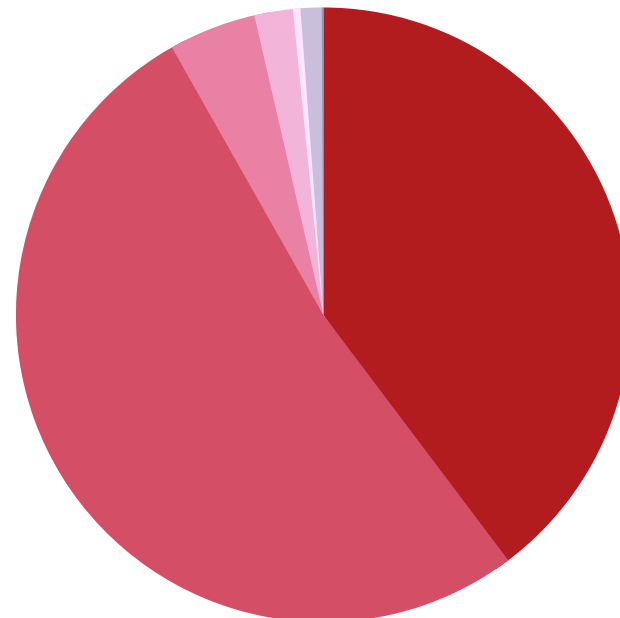
